Roy J. Smith Middle School: STEM Academy

Through the integration of a school within a school model, the middle school STEM Academy incorporates Project Based Learning instruction, while providing foundational coursework for students interested in pursuing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics related studies as they prepare for high school.

Killeen ISD Career Center

The Career Center provides academic choices and opportunities through 15 high demand career clusters. Students choosing to engage in career and technical education courses work with advanced resources and technologies to develop skills which meet today's industry standards. Students may take individual classes or enter a program of study to obtain industry level certifications and skills which lead to high paying technical jobs in the workforce.

Killeen ISD Early College High School

Killeen ISD ECHS students earn up to 60 college credit hours and an Associate of Arts degree in Interdisciplinary Studies in conjunction with their high school Foundation Diploma with Endorsement upon graduation. Killeen ISD and Central Texas College partner for this unique opportunity to serve students in the Killeen ISD attendance zone. Students have access to Central Texas College facilities, resources and services, including the faculty, libraries, labs, artistic and cultural activities, and extracurricular activities. Early College High School is funded through Killeen ISD. Killeen ISD pays for tuition, fees and required textbooks for enrolled students to the extent those charges are not waived by Central Texas College.

Texas Bioscience Institute

KISD fully funds student enrollment in the Texas Bioscience Institute. Texas Bioscience Institute is a competitive dual credit program offered in collaboration with Temple College and Baylor Scott and White Memorial Hospital. The program provides students the opportunity to earn college hours while receiving laboratory experience at a premiere bioscience research center. Students apply for admission during their sophomore year for half day attendance in their junior and senior years. Transportation between the high school and TBI is provided. The rigorous course of study provides coursework in preparation for students interested in careers in medicine and biotechnology. Upon successful completion, students may earn an associate degree from Temple College in addition to their high school diploma.

Pathways Academic Campus

The campus provides various schedule and course options with appropriate academic and support services to enable students to stay in school, or re-enter school, and pursue personalized educational goals. Students will work at a self-paced rate while pursuing a high school diploma.

Ellison High School: Leadership Academy

The Leadership Academy is an association of high performing students who strive to combine their individual talents to improve themselves, their school and the community. Members learn by doing, attending required monthly leadership seminars, and Academy committee meetings. Students work with a mentor in the community to learn about a profession, complete an independent project, and contribute 50 hours of community service.

Harker Heights High School: Fine Arts

The fine arts curriculum offers quality academic programs with an emphasis on a rigorous study in performing and fine arts areas which include: visual arts, dance, theatre, and music. Specialized areas of study available are orchestra, music theory, music production, and technical theatre. The Fine Arts Department fulfills the mission of educating the whole person by providing students a variety of opportunities in both performing and studio arts.

Killeen High School: International Baccalaureate

The globally focused International baccalaureate program provides students a rigorous program of study to promote international understanding. Students take courses in six academic areas in preparation for content area tests, participate in the Creativity, Action, and Service (CAS) component, and write an extended essay in order to receive an IB diploma and college credit accepted by universities around the world.

Shoemaker High School: STEM Academy

STEM education provides a course of study for students in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. The STEM Academy emphasizes learning as it relates to real-life situations. The STEM Academy strives to promote academic leadership and responsibility among students.
